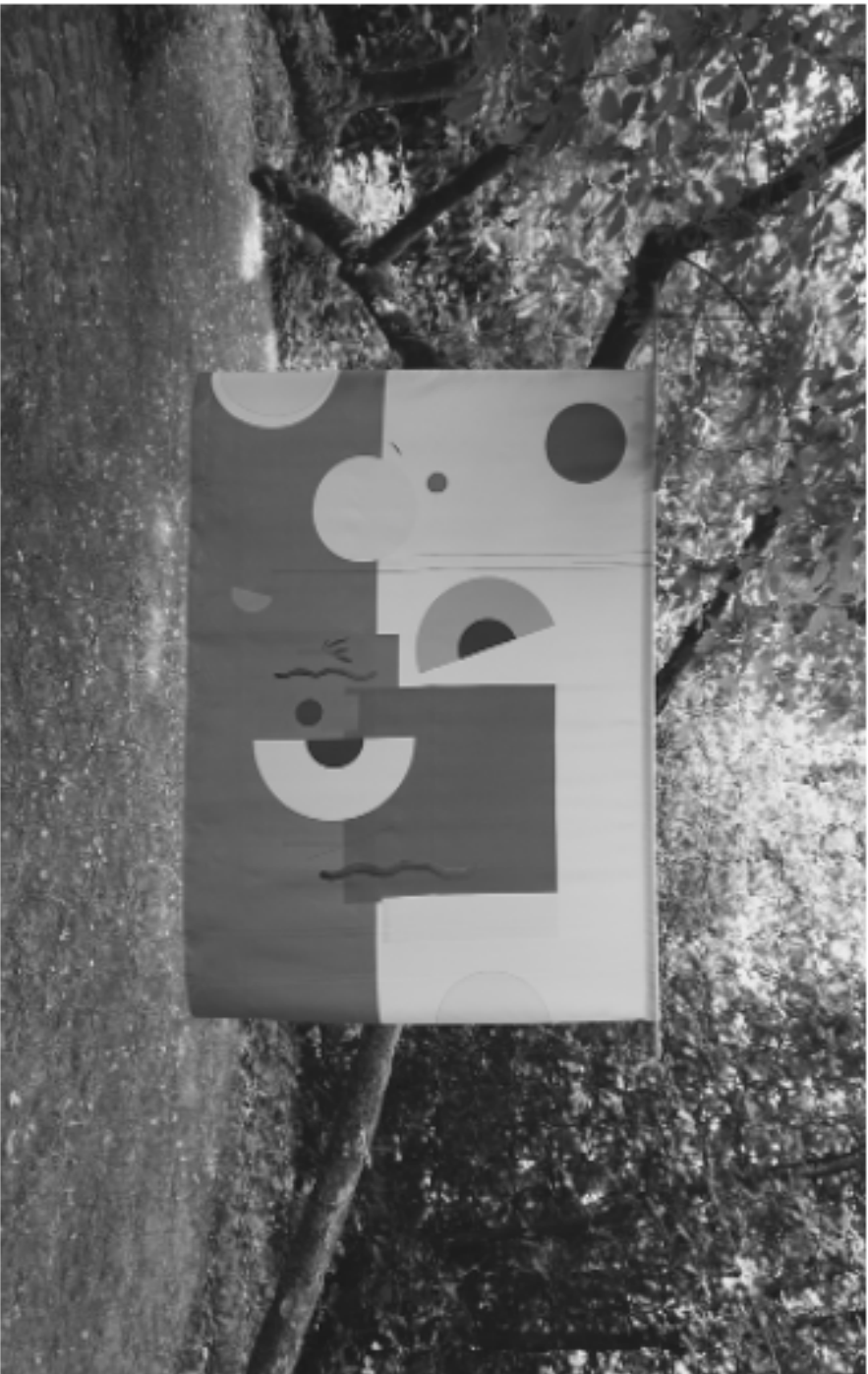

NOÉMIE LACROIX

By simplifying her subject matter to geometric shapes, Lacroix creates movement and depth as her forms are displaced, moving on, in and above one another.

Weaving in and out through space, the artist successfully creates volume through the blocks of coloured material.

HUGH FINDLETAR

Born in Jamaica, based in Italy, Hugh Findletar explores the sculptural peculiarities of form and colour through the expressive medium of Murano glass.

A photographer by trade, Hugh Findletar's fascination for portraiture developed beyond the camera lens as he experiments with different mediums. Hugh's imposing and bold art are featured in some of the world's most prestigious contemporary art collections as eccentric masterpieces that transcend the limits of sculpture.

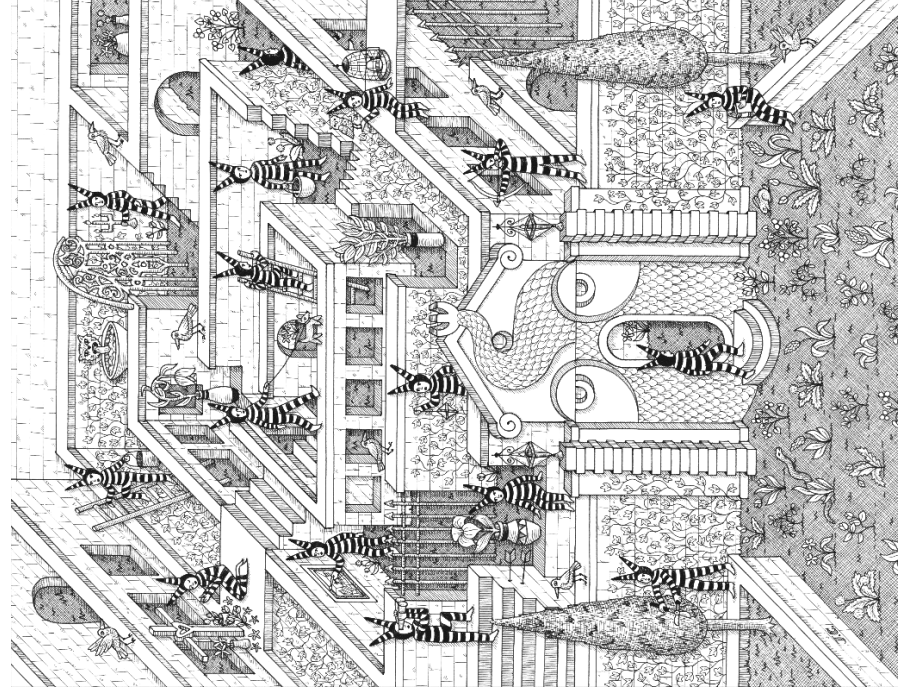
RUAN HOFFMAN

Using ceramic earthenware as his preferred medium, Ruan Hoffmann chooses familiar objects such as plates, containers and tiles as his canvases, however the resulting works are not presented as homey pieces emanating from the domestic sphere but as wilful, irregular and misshapen forms on which the artist's unedited observations on life's experiences flow in constant, noisy glimpses of thought.

Jayde Cardinalli is a California based designer and illustrator who takes inspiration from fashion, textiles, nature, and vintage ephemera. Jayde's illustrations were recently featured on clothing for GUCCI's runway show, after the celebrated creative director Alessandro Michele discovered her work on Instagram.
